APPRAISER CANDIDATE CLASSROOM COURSES

The Pa. Real Estate Appraiser candidate must have certain college course requirements, take approved appraisal courses (200 hours for RESIDENTIAL certification; 300 hours for GENERAL certification), serve as an “apprentice” or “trainee” for a certain time period, earn and document appraisal experience and take and pass a comprehensive appraisal exam.

The requirements to become a Pa. real estate APPRAISER have changed.
